4. Project promotes wellness and injury prevention and does not involve acute care treatment or rehabilitation. <b>0 – does not promote wellness</b> <b>1 – promotes wellness</b>										
5. Project will reach sufficient number of community residents to warrant funding. <b>0 – it does not</b> <b>1 – it does</b>										
6. Budget seems realistic for scope of project. <b>0 – it does not</b> <b>1 - it does</b>										
7. Project involves other community groups as partners. <b>0 – it does not</b> <b>1 – it does</b>
